








EYFS at Clifford Bridge – The Ms

Your child's learning is recorded using Tapestry-Online Learning Journal



Tapestry – Online Learning Journals



- An Online Learning Journal System
- EYFS Staff record children's learning and progression using Kindles and iPads
- Parents can view their child's journal on mobile devices, tablets and on home computers at any time!
- Parents can comment on observations or even add their own!
- A password and PIN is required to access Tapestry for all users.
- Parents can only view observations of their child (or with permission group/class observations)






How can you help prepare your child for starting Nursery
