- * Your child's learning is recorded using Tapestry on-line Learning Journals
- EYFS staff record children's learning and progression using iPads
- * Parents can view their child's journal on mobile devices, tablets/iPads and on home computers at any time!
- Parents can comment on observations or even add their own!





How is the data protected?

- A password and PIN is required to access Tapestry for all users.
- Parents can only view observations of their child (or with permission group/class observations).
- This site is hosted on Tapestry's own UK based servers in a secure data centre.
- Every school's data is stored separately.
- * Data is encrypted to a very high level.

Reading and Writing

All our reading and writing is taught through a phonics scheme called 'Read Write Inc.'

Read Write Inc. encourages children to know all their single sounds first (phonemes) and then moves on to blending the sounds to support reading

Read Write Inc.

Your child will initially be bringing home a story book without words to share

Once they have learnt their sounds and are beginning to blend some simple words they will be given a reading book from our reading scheme alongside some high frequency words to take home


